



**DRAFT MINUTES OF THE WELLBEING COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE
PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON
WEDNESDAY 25th NOVEMBER 2020 AT 7.30PM.**

219/20 To record those present and list of apologies

Those Present: Councillors: C Chapman and K Lamb.

Non-Council Committee Members – J Lamb, H Clements, A Gallon, M Martin, S Jacob, S Scott and the Clerk.

Apologies: Cllr S Peall. Non-Council members J Moat.

220/20 To declare any Disclosable Pecuniary Interests (DPI), Other significant Interests (OSI's) or a Voluntary interest relating to items on the agenda.

None were declared.

Cllr Chapman gave all members an update on services being provided by Elham Wellbeing and volunteers for the second lockdown.

221/20 Following a discussion regarding food poverty within and surrounding the parish, it was **agreed** that the Clerk would liaise with Trussell Trust and Elham Primary School to discuss collection points for the district food bank. AG and MM would liaise with Rev. Weeks, Mr File and Independent Food Networks. JL would produce poster campaign for the collection points.

222/20 Further to a brief discussion regarding KFC Social Isolation Campaign, it was **agreed** that elements of this campaign were already being covered by the volunteers of Elham Wellbeing and no further action is necessary.

223/20 Cllr Chapman reported back to the committee following the Age UK Round Table meeting where The Big Community Christmas was discussed. It was agreed that the campaign leaflet would be hand delivered to residents who most likely would not have access to social media, of which 5 streets were identified and displayed in village noticeboards.

224/20 Discussions regarding future projects would be on going due to the imminent announcement from the Government as to which tier we will fall into. It was **agreed** that the committee would keep in contact.
