## 171/21 Wellbeing

In the absence of the Chair of the Wellbeing Committee, the following was read to the meeting: Following our Well-being meeting on $19^{\text {th }}$ May, we addressed the following

- It was felt that anxiety and mental wellbeing will be an issue as we slowly ease out of lockdown and it was crucial that we were proactive rather than just reactive in addressing this and with that in mind, we set up a small group of 4 which included the community warden and a parishioner to consider ways of engagement, with a meeting already scheduled going forward update at the next meeting.
- National Volunteers week is $1^{\text {st }} 7^{\text {th }}$ June which is an opportunity to acknowledge the role volunteers played during lockdowns. During an exceptionally difficult year, people from the village took time to volunteer and make a huge difference to our community. The Parish Council will be showing their appreciation on Saturday $26^{\text {th }}$ June (government guidelines allowing for bigger groups to meet outside after the $21^{\text {st }}$ June) at the Gore with refreshments being provided. We will also be inviting some members of the community to join in with this "Vote of Thanks"
It was discussed and agreed that the Wellbeing Committee can spend $£ 200$ on the event.

172/21 Community and Amenities
Queens Green Canopy - The Queen's Green Canopy is a unique tree planting initiative created to mark Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee in 2022. It was discussed that a working group will be set up consisting of Village organisations to lead the initiative for the Parish. Member of the Council on the Working Group are Cllr Lamb, Cllr Swan and Cllr Kirchner.
Community Memorial Table - The memorial table is in production. The proposed planting scheme to the area surrounding the table has been issued to Elham Village Hall and will be on their agenda for their meeting on 21st June. Thank you to the Elham Community Trust who have donated $£ 500$ and the Elham Residents Association who have donated $£ 200$ towards the cost of the community memorial table.

## 173/21 Highways

Regarding the carriageway damage in The Square caused by the tankering, KCC Highways are in discussions with Southern Water as to whose responsibility it is to commission the repair works. The damage to the highway that caused the reported incident has been repaired temporarily.
Regarding the bollards to Canterbury Road, Elham Parish Council were not consulted on this matter and are make further enquiries. Deferred until next meeting due in the absence of the Highways Lead.

## 175/21 King George V

A resident had expressed concern that a beech tree, growing very close to their boundary, is causing issues over overshadowing, lack of light and general encroachment upon their property. The tree was inspected, and the recommendation of the Tree Warden was that the tree be removed in the autumn and replaced with a more suitable tree. It was agreed that further investigation would be required.

## 178/21 Verbal report was received from: <br> District Councillor - Stuart Peall

The service - which will be operated by Stagecoach - will run from the Motis Business Centre in Cheriton near J12 of the M20, CT19 4 QJ. Users can enjoy hassle free parking paying just $£ 5$ per car to park all day. Shuttle buses will run every 30 minutes between 9am and 6 pm to Folkestone Harbour via Folkestone Central Station. The park and ride service will operate every weekend until October and daily from 19 July to 31 August.
This park and ride service is a pilot to assess demand and help alleviate parking congestion in the harbour area during the summer months. The service has been made possible by Welcome Back funding from government.

FHDC are studying electric charging points with the aim of rolling this out.
It may have been noticed that Veolia have failed to empty bins and everything related to waste services within the District. This stems from a requirement from Veolia to how they deliver the services across Dover District Council and Folkestone and Hythe District Council. Veolia have changed the route, crews and other aspects of the services but not the number of vehicles used for the routes.
We expected some teething problems just due to the sheer number of properties affected by the route changes. However, the changes are taking longer than expected to bed in which means that the normally excellent levels of collection services aren't being met for a large number of households. This just isn't good enough and we apologise to all residents affected. An extraordinary meeting is being held as soon as possible to resolve this situation.

The litter pick in Elham was a success. There was not a huge amount of litter which is a testimony to the residents of Elham. Following the requests of some of the residents, I will be providing litter picking equipment to the Parish.

## 179/21 Consultation

The government has launched a consultation seeking views on proposed planning reforms that will allow the deployment of telecoms equipment to be quicker whilst ensuring that there are appropriate environmental protections and safeguards in place. Proposals being consulted on include permitting alteration, replacement or increases in width and height to existing masts so sites can be upgraded for 5G and for mast sharing, and enabling higher, new masts to deliver better mobile coverage and mast sharing. This technical consultation follows an earlier consultation on the principle of these proposed reforms. This consultation closes at 11:45pm on 14 June 2021.
It was agreed that Cllr Lamb and Cllr Swan would look at the consultation and if required would response on behalf of the Council.
