119/22 Chairman's Report

On behalf of the Parish Council, I would like to express our thanks to Jan Stanyon and the EHVA for making the Platinum Jubilee event such a success. It was a positive collaboration between the Parish Council and the Elham Village Hall Association.

We have been approached by a group intending to use the Gore for football on a weekly basis on a Saturday. They have registered with Kent FA / Canterbury League as Elham Valley football team. They will begin using for The Gore for pre-season training.

Thank you to Mr Verney who has generously donated £100 towards the upkeep of the burial ground.

We have planted the Platinum Jubilee Mulberry tree in the north end of the King George V. Name plaques for all the Jubilee trees are to follow.

122/22 C&A Committee

There is to be a family afternoon at The Gore to raise funds for Play for Elham. This will take place at the end of the summer academic term.

The Clerk is to obtain a further quote for the professional fees for the proposed works to the Gore. Amended drawings will be discussed with full Council at the July Ordinary meeting of the Parish Council.

123/22 Outside Bodies

Confusingly, following on from an Elham Community Trust member approaching the Parish Council to suggest that the Parish Council provide a representative for the Trust, the following correspondence was received:

"Your email has been discussed by the Trust having been received with some consternation, the Trust have never requested a Parish Council nomination and were not prepared to have one imposed on it. I am pleased however to convey for information that after discussion the Trust members were acceptable to a further Trust member and considered that Brian Swan, as a local resident would be an ideal candidate, additionally he could keep the Parish Council informed of the Trusts actions. I would like to send Brian a formal invitation and the necessary Charity forms for completion and would appreciate his address accordingly".

In the absence of County Councillor Susan Carey, a report was read to the room: I hope you all enjoyed the Platinum Jubilee celebrations. Kent Highways waived the normal fees for road closures for street parties and approved 575 closures which was by far the largest total for a county in the UK. We also had the largest number of beacons!

KCC continues to work with other public sector partners on the Homes for Ukraine scheme. So far 1,281 Ukrainians have arrived in Kent as part of this scheme, There will undoubtedly be more Ukrainians arriving as there is a separate scheme for those joining family and no one is obliged to register with us. We also expect numbers to rise as more visas are issued.

The Government has allocated KCC a £11m grant to help families and other vulnerable people; it will be used for Free School Meals for the May half term, as well as a £50 flat rate assistance for the summer holidays, along with support for vulnerable residents' energy and water bills and other help to those experiencing financial hardship. Our KentTogether helpline 03000 41 92 92 is the place to go for help.

I'm pleased to say that Operation Brock on the M20 has just been lifted. Over the Platinum Jubilee holiday freight volumes were 30% higher than predicted and tourist traffic was also up including large numbers of people turning up without a booking. The underlying problems of too much traffic being funnelled down the M20 to Eurotunnel and Dover Harbour remains unresolved and KCC continues to press Government to provide the infrastructure needed.

National Highways, formerly Highways England gave a presentation to KCC Members on the Lower Thames Crossing. This will be a tunnel which will divert much freight traffic away from the M20 and the Dartford crossing. They are still expecting the project to complete by 2030 though this seems ambitious for a project of this size and complexity.
